WHAT ARE YOUR TOP 3 LIFE HIGHLIGHTS?


- 1. In 2016, traveling to my mom's home country, Romania, and seeing all the castles in Transylvania.



THE COOKING CORNER

Halloween Caramel Apples

<u>Ingredi</u>ents

- 1/2 cup butter
- 2 cups packed brown sugar
- 1 cup light corn syrup
- dash of salt
- 1 (14 ounce) can sweetened, condensed milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup white vinegar (optional for washing apples)
- 12 crisp apples, washed and dried
- 12 thick cookie sticks
- Optional toppings such as chopped nuts, Halloween sprinkles or candy, chocolate chips



Directions

- 1. Wash and dry apples.
- 2. Press sticks into the tops of apples and place on parchment
- 3. Melt butter in medium saucepan over medium heat.
- 4. Add brown sugar, corn syrup, and salt.
- 5. Cook and stir over medium heat until mixture reaches a full rolling boil.
- 6.Add milk.
- 7. Continue cooking and stirring until mixture reaches precisely 248 degrees on a candy thermometer.
- 8. Remove from heat and add vanilla.
- 9. Dip apples to coat with caramel.
- 10. Add toppings if you like.
- 11. Allow to cool on parchment paper.
- 12. Store in refrigerator.
- 13. Enjoy!
